### Requirements

**U.S. Service Member Applicants may meet content knowledge and experience requirements as follows:**

- U.S. Air Force, Army, Coast Guard, Marine Corps, Navy or Space Force members: three or more years' active duty
- Guard/Reserves: 10 years' experience, or five years' experience with 12 months active-duty deployment
- Military Occupational Specialty (MOS), time of service and an honorable discharge must be verified on a DD-214 member copy 4 (submitted in application)

**All other applicants must meet content knowledge and occupational requirements outlined below:**

- Hold:
  - a valid Colorado teacher license in any secondary (7-12) content area or in a world language (K-12), a valid Colorado CTE authorization or a valid Colorado Special Services license **OR**
  - a bachelor's degree and 2,000 hours of verified occupational experience **OR**
  - an associate's degree from a community college **AND** 4,000 hours of verified occupational experience.
- Have completed the Colorado Community College System Work-based Learning Coordinator Program, as outlined below:
