Requirements

U.S. Service Member Applicants may meet content knowledge and experience requirements as follows:

- U.S. Air Force, Army, Coast Guard, Marine Corps, Navy or Space Force members: three or more years' active duty
- Guard/Reserves: 10 years' experience, or five years' experience with 12 months active-duty deployment
- Military Occupational Specialty (MOS), time of service and an honorable discharge must be verified on a DD-214 member copy 4 (submitted in application)

All other applicants must meet content knowledge and occupational requirements outlined below:

Content Knowledge:

- Hold an associate or higher degree in any area, with at least 24 semester hours of post-secondary coursework (as verified on an official transcript) to include a minimum of three (3) semester hours in four (4) of the categories outlined below **OR**
- Hold earned, valid Veterinary Technician Certification.

Occupational Experience:

- Bachelor's or higher degree: 2,000 hours verified occupational (non-teaching) experience in the content area **OR**
- Associate's degree: 4,000 hours verified occupational (non-teaching) experience in the content area **OR**
- Three (3) years' verified teaching experience in the content area (full-time is defined as 51% or more of a teaching schedule dedicated to teaching in the content area).
